Text: Daniel 2:1-23

**Passage Summary:** While much of life can seem like a mystery, we take great comfort in knowing that the God we worship and serve is a \_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_!

**180 Degree Truth #1:** See that when you are lost in the mystery, God is more \_\_\_\_\_ to give us needed \_\_\_\_\_ to remain faithful to Him than we may realize! (2:1-23)

**Application:** Recognize that when it comes to receiving revelation from God...

- Be \_\_\_\_\_: Seek to understand before you \_\_\_\_\_! (v.1-16)

**Remember:** When it comes to receiving revelation from God, it is essential that we resist the temptation to panic, but instead, address the situation with \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_!

- Be \_\_\_\_\_: Invite God into your mystery through \_\_\_\_\_! (v.17-19)

**Remember:** When it comes to receiving revelation from God, "This is what the Lord says, he who made the earth, the Lord who formed it and established it—the Lord is his name: ' \_\_\_\_\_ to me and I will \_\_\_\_\_ you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know.'" (Jeremiah 33:2-3)

- Be \_\_\_\_\_: God is more \_\_\_\_\_ than we could ever fully realize! (v.20-23)

**Core Conviction to Live By:** Resolutely determine that in a world of compromise and deception that you will stand for God and the truth of the gospel; although we are weak and fragile in and of ourselves, the Bible reminds us that "we have this treasure in jars of \_\_\_\_\_ to show that this all-surpassing \_\_\_\_\_ is from God and not from us."
